BACKGROUND

Endoglycan, also named podocalyxin-like 2 (PODXL2), is a member of the CD34 family of sialomucins. It is a Type I transmembrane protein expressed on endothelial cells, early hematopoietic progenitors and leukocyte subpopulations. Specific endoglycan glycoforms function as L-Selectin ligands.

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
