BACKGROUND

This peptide sequence is identical to amino acids 162-184 of human RSK3 (RPS6KA2). The sequence differs at one position from amino acids 165-187 of human RSK1 (RPS6KA1) and at two positions from amino acids 176-198 of human RSK4 (RPS6KA6). The immunogen is also highly homologous to the corresponding sequences of mouse and rat RSK family isoforms.

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
