BACKGROUND

TGF- β RI, also known as activin-like kinase 5 (ALK-5), is a 55 kDa type I transmembrane serine/threonine receptor kinase. It is ubiquitously expressed and forms a functional heterotetrameric signaling TGF- β receptor complex with TGF- β RII. The amino acid sequence of human TGF- β RI extracellular domain is 91%, 90%, 91%, and 93% identical to that of porcine, mouse, bovine, and rat TGF- β RI, respectively.

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
