BACKGROUND

Heme Oxygenase 1 (HO-1), also known as HMOX1 and Heat Shock Protein 32 (HSP32), is a 32 kDa microsomal enzyme required for the metabolism of heme to biliverdin. Heme oxygenase occurs as 2 isozymes, an inducible heme oxygenase-1 (HO-1/HMOX1) and a constitutive heme oxygenase-2 (HO-2/HMOX2). HO-1 expression is induced by heme and other non-heme compounds. Rat HO-1 shares 93% amino acid sequence identity with mouse HO-1.

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
