#### BACKGROUND

Aurora A is a serine/threonine kinase that regulates chromosome segregation and cytokinesis during mitosis. Its kinase activity is thought to regulate the G<sub>2</sub> to M transition of the cell cycle by phosphorylating BRCA1. Aberrant expression and activity of Aurora A in tumors, including breast, ovarian, gastric and colorectal cancer, suggests that it plays a role in tumor development and progression.
