BACKGROUND

The Raf serine/threonine kinases are effectors of Ras that function as MAP3Ks in the ERK phosphorylation cascade. Mammals express three Raf proteins: Raf-1 (C-Raf); A-Raf; and B-Raf, found at high levels in cerebrum and testes. Mice with a targeted disruption of the B-Raf gene die of vascular defects during mid-gestation. B-Raf mutations have been found in two-thirds of malignant melanomas, with the single substitution V599E in the kinase domain the most frequent occurrence. B-Raf activation in melanomas results in BIM phosphorylation and inhibition of apoptosis.
