BACKGROUND

I κ B kinase gamma (IKK γ) is also known as NF- κ B essential modulator (NEMO), IKBKG, and FIP3. The active IKK complex, composed of IKK α , IKK β , and two forms of processed IKK γ (50 and 55 kDa), phosphorylates and inactivates I κ B, resulting in the release and nuclear translocation of active NF- κ B. The regulatory IKK γ is required for activation of the IKK complex.

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
