BACKGROUND

Mixed-lineage kinases (MLKs) function as mitogen-activated protein kinase kinase kinases (MAP3Ks), activating the MAPK signaling cascades. MLK3, also known as MAP3K11 and PTK1, encodes a protein of 847 amino acids (aa) that shares an unusual leucine zipper-basic motif found in other MLKs. Small interfering RNA experiments have indicated that MLK3 is required for both mitogen and cytokine activation of JNK1, p38α, and ERK1.

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
