BACKGROUND

SOCS-5 (Suppressor of cytokine signaling 5; also CIS-6) is a 55-60 kDa member of the SOCS family of proteins. It is an SH2-domain containing cytoplasmic adaptor protein expressed by Th1 cells that is known to reduce the expression of the EGF receptor and block signaling by the IL-4 Rα chain. Human SOCS-5 is 536 amino acids (aa) in length. It contains one SH2 domain (aa 381-476) and a SOCS box (aa 471-520) that mediates interaction with E3 ubiquitin ligase complexes. Full-length SOCS-5 is 94% aa identical to mouse SOCS-5.

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
