BACKGROUND

ISG15 (interferon-induced 15 kDa protein; also IP17) is a 15 kDa ubiquitin family protein that is expressed by a wide variety of cell types. ISG15 is induced by type I IFN, and like ubiquitin, becomes conjugated to intracellular proteins. Unlike ubiquitin, it does not target proteins for degradation, instead, it is part of the anti-virus response. Human proISG15 is 165 amino acids (aa) in length. There are two ubiquitin-like domains (aa 2-78 and 79-157) and a propeptide (aa 15-165) that is cleaved intracellularly. Select blood mononuclear cells secrete mature ISG15, which is chemotactic for neutrophils. Mature human ISG15 is 66% aa identical to mouse ISG15.

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
