BACKGROUND

LRP11 (Low-density lipoprotein receptor-related protein 11) is a 500 amino acid single-pass type I membrane glycoprotein that exists as 2 alternatively spliced isoforms with predicted molecular weights of 53 and 25 kDa, observed 60 and 35 kDa respectively. LRP11 is a novel member of the LDLR family of proteins. Over aa 38-450, human LRP11 shares 67% aa identity with mouse LRP11.

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
