BACKGROUND

The common β chain, also known as CD131, is a transmembrane protein that associates with the ligand-specific IL-3 R α , IL-5 R α , or GM-CSF R α proteins to form high affinity receptor complexes. β c is expressed on a variety of hematopoietic cells.
