Biotinylated Anti-mouse EphB2 Antibody

Preparation

Produced in goats immunized with purified, NS0-derived, recombinant mouse EphB2 (rmEphB2) extracellular domain. EphB2 specific IgG was purified by mouse EphB2 affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

Formulation

Lyophilized from a 0.2 μ m filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS) containing 50 μ g of bovine serum albumin (BSA) per 1 μ g of antibody.

Reconstitution

Reconstitute with sterile Tris-buffered saline pH 7.3 (20 mM Trizma base, 150 mM NaCl) containing 0.1% BSA. If 1 mL of buffer is used, the antibody concentration will be 50 μ g/mL.

Storage

Lyophilized samples are stable for twelve months from date of receipt when stored at -20° C to -70° C. Upon reconstitution, the antibody can be stored at 2° - 8° C for 1 month without detectable loss of activity. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquotted and stored frozen at -20° C to -70° C in a manual defrost freezer for six months without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Specificity

This antibody has been selected for use as a detection antibody in mouse EphB2 western blots. In western blots, this antibody shows approximately 5% cross-reactivity with rmEphB6, rrEphB1 and rmEphB3.

Application

Western Blot - This antibody can be used at 0.1 - 0.2 μ g/mL with the appropriate secondary reagents to detect mouse EphB2. The detection limit for rmEphB2 is approximately 10 ng/lane under non-reducing and reducing conditions.

Optimal dilutions should be determined by each laboratory for each application.
