# Biotinylated Anti-human Caspr2 Antibody

## **Preparation**

Produced in sheep immunized with purified, NS0-derived, recombinant human Caspr2 isoform 1 extracellular domain (rhCaspr2; aa 29 - 1262; Accession # Q9UHC6). Human Caspr2 specific IgG was purified by human Caspr2 affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from a 0.2  $\mu$ m filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS) containing 50  $\mu$ g of bovine serum albumin (BSA) per 1  $\mu$ g of antibody.

### Reconstitution

Reconstitute with sterile Tris-buffered saline pH 7.3 (20 mM Trizma base, 150 mM NaCl) containing 0.1% BSA. If 1 mL of buffer is used, the antibody concentration will be 50  $\mu$ g/mL.

## Storage

Lyophilized samples are stable for twelve months from date of receipt when stored at -20° C to -70° C. Upon reconstitution, the antibody can be stored at 2° - 8° C for 1 month without detectable loss of activity. Reconstituted antibody can also be aliquotted and stored frozen at -20° C to -70° C in a manual defrost freezer for six months without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

## **Specificity**

This antibody has been selected for use as a detection antibody in human Caspr2 Western blots.

## **Application**

Western blot - This antibody can be used at 0.1 - 0.2  $\mu$ g/mL with the appropriate secondary reagents to detect human Caspr2. The detection limit for rhCaspr2 is approximately 5 ng/lane under non-reducing and reducing conditions.

Optimal dilutions should be determined by each laboratory for each application.
