BACKGROUND

Aldehyde Dehydrogenase 2 (ALDH2) is a protein involved in the pathway which synthesizes acetate from ethanol. It also functions as a protector against oxidative stress. The ALDH2 isoform is localized to the mitochondrial matrix. Genetic variation in ALDH2 in the East Asian population is associated with high instances of acute alcohol intoxication.

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
