BACKGROUND

Salivary gland protein LTRIN, a 15 Kilodalton protein from mosquito *Aedes aegypti*, has been shown to facilitate the transmission of Zika virus (ZIKV) probably by interfering with signaling through the lymphotoxin-β receptor (LTβR).
