## BACKGROUND

GPR83 is an orphan G protein-coupled receptor most homologous to the tachykinin and neuropeptide Y receptors. GPR83 is involved in the conversion of naive CD4+CD25- T-cells into CD4+Foxp3+ Treg cells during inflammatory immune responses in vivo.
