Human Hydroxycarboxylic acid receptor 1 (HCAR1), also known as GPR81 and GPR194, is a G-protein coupled receptor (GPCR) that acts as a receptor for L-lactate and mediates its anti-lipolytic effect through a G(i)-protein-mediated pathway.

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
