BACKGROUND

Hepassocin, also known as hepatocyte-derived fibrinogen-related protein (HFREP-1) and Fibrinogen-like protein 1 (FGL-1), is a liver specific secreted protein containing one fibrinogen C-terminal domain. It exists as a homodimer and is reported to have hepatocyte mitogenic activity. Hepassocin/FGL-1 binds LAG3 independently from MHC class II (MHC-II) and acts as an Immune suppressive molecule that inhibits antigen-specific T-cell activation by acting as a major ligand of LAG3.

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
