BACKGROUND

The α 4 subunit, also known as CD49d and VLA-4 α subunit, forms heterodimers with Integrin β 1 (CD29) or β 7. Integrins α 4 β 1 and α 4 β 7 are receptors for fibronectin and VCAM. Integrin α 4 β 1 also binds the mucosal addressin cell adhesion molecule (MAdCAM-1).

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
