BACKGROUND

Lymphotoxin β is a type II transmembrane protein member of the TNF ligand superfamily and is now designated TNFSF3. Lymphotoxin β associates with Lymphotoxin α to form two types of heterotrimers, Lymphotoxin α₁β₂ and Lymphotoxin α₂β₁. Lymphotoxin β is expressed by activated CD4 T cells, unpolarized IL-2-secreting effector T cells, and Th1 effector cells.

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
