BACKGROUND

GATA-1 is the founding member of the GATA family of transcription factors, which bind to the consensus DNA sequence (A/T) GATA (A/G) to control diverse tissue-specific programs of gene expression and morphogenesis. GATA-1 is expressed in blood forming cells. It interacts with several additional proteins to activate or repress gene expression and is essential for erythropoiesis.

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
