BACKGROUND

CCR5 is a G protein-linked seven transmembrane domain chemokine receptor. CCR5 serves as a receptor for several chemokines including MIP-1α, MIP-1β, MCP-2, and RANTES. It also functions as a co-receptor for Macrophage Tropic HIV-1 infection.

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
