BACKGROUND

IL-12 Rβ2 is a type I cytokine receptor family protein that associates with IL 12 Rβ1 to form a functional high affinity receptor complex for IL-12. The extracellular region of IL 12 Rβ2 contains five fibronectin type 3 domains. The cytoplasmic region is alternatively spliced, giving rise to two isoforms. IL-12 Rβ2 is up-regulated in Th1 cells during inflammatory responses. The extracellular regions of human and mouse IL-12 Rβ2 share 69% amino acid sequence identity.

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
