BACKGROUND

Smads are a family of intracellular proteins that transmit transforming growth factor beta (TGF-β) superfamily signals from the cell surface to the nucleus. Upon signal-induced phosphorylation, Smad subunits associate with the common-mediator subunit, Smad4. This heteromeric complex then translocates into the nucleus to exert transcriptional modulator activity.

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
