#### BACKGROUND

Vasorin is a type I membrane protein that is predominantly expressed in vascular smooth muscle cells in a developmentally regulated pattern. Expression is down-regulated during vessel repair after arterial injury. Vasorin directly binds to transforming growth factor (TGF)-β and attenuates TGF-β signaling *in vitro* (1).
