BACKGROUND

Granulocyte Macrophage Colony Stimulating Factor (GM-CSF) is a growth factor produced by a variety of lymphoid cells. It binds to receptor heterodimers consisting of a GM-CSF-specific α chain and the common β chain that is shared by the high-affinity receptors for IL-3 and IL-5.

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
