BACKGROUND

Phospholipase C gamma-1 (PLC-γ1) is activated by receptor tyrosine kinases in response to growth factors and hormones. Activated PLC-γ1 catalyzes the hydrolysis of phosphatidylinositol 4,5-bisphosphate to produce the second messengers inositol 1,4,5-trisphosphate (IP₃) and diacylglycerol (DAG). IP₃ mobilizes the release of calcium while DAG activates protein kinase C. PLC-γ1 plays an important role in regulating cell proliferation and differentiation.

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
