BACKGROUND

NFκB inhibitor beta (IκB-β) inhibits the NFκB complex by binding and sequestering it in the cytoplasm. Upon stimulation, IκB-β is phosphorylated on serine residues marking it for degradation by the ubiquitin pathway. Following IκB-β degradation, the NFκB complex is able to translocate to the nucleus and activate transcription.

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
