BACKGROUND

CXCL12, also known as SDF-1, is a CXC chemokine that interacts with CXCR4. SDF-1α and SDF-1β are alternatively spliced isoforms of CXCL12. SDF-1β has an additional 4 amino acids at the carboxy-terminus.

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
