BACKGROUND

IκB kinase alpha (IKKα) is also known as IKBKA, CHUK, and IKK1. The classical active IKK complex, composed of IKKα, IKKβ, and two forms of processed IKKγ, phosphorylates and inactivates IκB, resulting in the release and nuclear translocation of active NF-κB. IKKα contains kinase, leucine zipper, and helix-loop-helix domains, and heterodimerizes with IKKβ. NF-κB-inducing kinase (NIK) phosphorylates and activates IKKα.

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
