BACKGROUND

Claudin-11 is a 207 amino acid multipass membrane protein in the claudin family of epithelial tight junction proteins. Claudin-11 is widely expressed and is involved in epithelial remodeling during spermatogenesis and inner ear mechanotransduction. Claudin-11 is up-regulated in some cancers. Human Claudin-11 shares 94% aa sequence identity with mouse and rat Claudin-11.

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
