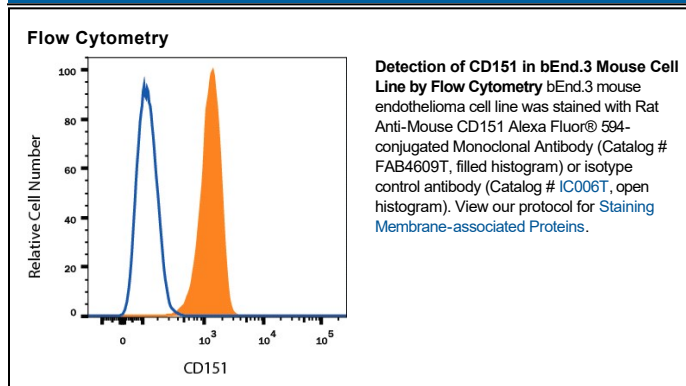

PREPARATION AND STORAGE

Shipping	The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended below.

BACKGROUND

CD151 is a 29 kDa palmitoylated glycoprotein in the tetraspanin superfamily and is expressed by endothelial cells, epithelial cells, megakaryocytes, and platelets. It associates with other tetraspanin proteins and with some integrins including α3/β1, α6/β1, α6/β4, and α7/β1. CD151 modulates cellular adhesion, cell migration, and platelet activation. Mouse CD151 shares 94%-96% aa sequence identity with human and rat CD151.

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
