BACKGROUND

Sema3b (Semaphorin 3B) is a 748 aa secreted glycoprotein. Mouse Sema3b shares 88% and 96% aa identity with human and rat Sema3b, respectively. The semaphorin family has been demonstrated to play a role in axon guidance. Additionally, Sema3b has been implicated in bone mass regulation and tumor suppression.

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
