BACKGROUND

Mesoderm development candidate gene 2 (MESDC2), also known as Boca in *Drosophila*, is a 22 kDa protein that is required for formation of the primitive streak and mesoderm during embryogenesis. MESDC2 binds to the Wnt co-receptors LRP5 and LRP6 in the endoplasmic reticulum and is required for their proper folding and cell surface expression. Within aa 34-234, human MESDC2 shares 87% aa sequence identity with mouse and rat MESDC2, respectively.

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
