BACKGROUND

Calcium/calmodulin-dependent protein kinase type II alpha (CaMKII α) belongs to a family of multifunctional serine/threonine kinases activated in response to increases in intracellular calcium. There are 4 CaMKII isozymes, α , β , γ , and δ , and each can yield several isoforms through alternative splicing. CaMKII isoforms assemble into homo- or heteromultimeric holoenzymes composed of 8 to 12 subunits. CaMKII α is predominantly expressed in the brain. It shares 100% aa sequence identity between human, mouse, and rat within aa 144-262 of isoform 1.

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
