BACKGROUND

Brg1 (Brm/Swi2-related gene 1), also known as SMARCA4 (Swi/SNF-related matrix-associated actin-dependent regulator of chromatin, subfamily A, member 4), SNF2L4 and SNF2β, is a 205 kDa member of the SNF2 helicase family of molecules. It is a ubiquitously expressed, nuclear-localized chromatin remodeling ATPase that, depending upon its associated complex, may both facilitate and inhibit gene transcription. Human SMARCA4 is 1647 amino acids (aa) in length, and contains an HSA domain (aa 460-532), one BRK region (aa 610-654), six potential phosphoserine sites between aa 610-662, a DEXDc domain that unwinds RNA and DNA (aa 774-913), one Bromo domain (aa 1477-1547) and eight potential phosphoserine sites between aa 1570-1644.
