BACKGROUND

Bone morphogenetic protein 10 (BMP-10) is a TGF-β superfamily member whose expression is restricted to the developing and postnatal heart. It is synthesized as a 424 amino acid (aa) pre-proprotein with a putative 21 aa signal peptide, a 292 aa propeptide, and a 108 aa mature protein. Mature BMP-10 is secreted as a 25 kDa disulfide-linked homodimer. The mouse BMP-10 proprotein shares 86% and 95% aa sequence identity with human and rat BMP-10, respectively.

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
