## BACKGROUND

AG-3 (Anterior gradient protein 3; also known as AGR3 and BCMP11) is a 17 kDa (predicted) member of the AGR family of proteins. It is expressed by intestinal epithelial and breast cancer cells. AG-3 is presumably secreted and binds to both α-dystroglycan and C4.4a/LYPD3. Mature human AG-3 is 145 amino acids (aa) in length (aa 22-166). Over aa 22-166, human AG-3 shares 92% amino acid sequence identity with mouse AG-3.
