BACKGROUND

Calcium/calmodulin-dependent protein kinase type II gamma (CaMKIIγ) belongs to a family of multifunctional serine/threonine kinases activated in response to increases in intracellular calcium. There are 4 CaMKII isozymes, α, β, γ, and δ, and each can yield several isoforms through alternative splicing. CaMKII isoforms assemble into homo- or heteromultimeric holoenzymes composed of 8 to 12 subunits. The widely expressed CaMKIIγ from human, mouse, and rat share 100% aa sequence identity within aa 448-558 of isoform 1.

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
