BACKGROUND

Orexin A and Orexin B are neuropeptide hormones derived from proteolytic processing of the Orexin precursor protein (Accession # O43612). Orexins are released from the hypothalamus and are involved in the regulation of sleeping patterns, feeding, and metabolism.

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
