BACKGROUND

FTH (Ferritin Heavy Chain 1; also Proliferation-Inducing Protein 15, PIG15, and PLIF) is a 183 aa cytosolic and secreted protein (SwissProt #: P02794). Human FTH is highly conserved among species and shares 93% and 95% aa identity with mouse and rat FTH, respectively. It is important for iron homeostasis by storing iron in a soluble form readily available to cells as well as having ferroxidase activity. Additionally, FTH plays a role in iron delivery to cells and can be secreted in small amounts in the serum as an iron carrier.

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
