MICL, also known as killer cell lectin-like receptor 1 (KLR1), is an inhibitory C-type lectin-like receptor that contains an immunoreceptor tyrosine-based inhibitory motif (ITIM). It is a75 kDa type II membrane protein that is expressed on neutrophils, NK cells, monocytes and dendritic cells. The amino acid sequence of mouse MICL extracellular domain is 53%, 52% and 58% identical to that of human, bovine and canine MICL, respectively

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
