PREPARATION AND STORAGE

Shipping	The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended below.
Stability & Storage	Protect from light. Do not freeze. 12 months from date of receipt, 2 to 8 °C as supplied

BACKGROUND

Cetuximab is a biosimilar directed against the extracellular domain of EGFR. This product constitutes the immunogen used for the anti-Idiotypic catalog number MAB9626. The biotinylated antibody (catalog number FAB9577B) can be used in flow cytometry or various assay format to measure EGFR expression and can be detected by conjugated streptavidin.

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
