D-Luciferin sodium salt is a firefly luciferase substrate ($K_m = {\sim}2~\mu M$). Used in many standard bioluminescence imaging (BLI) techniques, including monitoring tumour growth, and investigating intracellular signaling activity in vitro and in vivo. Cell permeable. Emission maximum = 562 nm.

Solutions of this product should be made with solvents purged with nitrogen. We do not recommend storing aqueous solutions for more than one day.

Stability and Solubility Advice:

Some solutions can be difficult to obtain and can be encouraged by rapid stirring, sonication or gentle warming (in a 45-60°C water bath).

Information concerning product stability, particularly in solution, has rarely been reported and in most cases we can only offer a general guide. *Unless contradicted by product-specific protocols or instructions, our standard recommendations apply:

SOLIDS: Provided storage is as stated on the product label and the vial is kept tightly sealed, the product can be stored for up to 6 months from date of receipt.

SOLUTIONS: We recommend that stock solutions, once prepared, are stored aliquoted in tightly sealed vials at -20°C or below and used within 1 month. Wherever possible solutions should be made up and used on the same day.
