Thalidomide 4'-oxyacetamide-PEG1-amine is a cereblon ligand for PROTAC® research and development; incorporates a cereblon ligand plus a PEG linker with terminal amine ready for conjugation to a target protein ligand. Part of a range of functionalized tool molecules for PROTAC R&D. This product has been recently renamed. The previous name for this product was Thalidomide - linker 13 PROTAC® is a registered trademark of Arvinas Operations, Inc., and is used under license.

Solubility & Usage Info:

This compound is hygroscopic and may absorb atmospheric moisture during prolonged storage, causing the solid to become sticky and/or collapse into a gel or glass-like form. Although purity is unaffected, it may be difficult to extract the full quantity from the vial. In such a situation, we recommend that solutions are made by adding solvent directly to the vial. The vial should then be vortexed vigorously to ensure the product has completely dissolved.

Stability and Solubility Advice:

Some solutions can be difficult to obtain and can be encouraged by rapid stirring, sonication or gentle warming (in a 45-60°C water bath).

Information concerning product stability, particularly in solution, has rarely been reported and in most cases we can only offer a general guide. Our standard recommendations are:

SOLIDS: Provided storage is as stated on the product label and the vial is kept tightly sealed, the product can be stored for up to 6 months from date of receipt.

SOLUTIONS: We recommend that stock solutions, once prepared, are stored aliquoted in tightly sealed vials at -20°C or below and used within 1 month. Wherever possible solutions should be made up and used on the same day.
