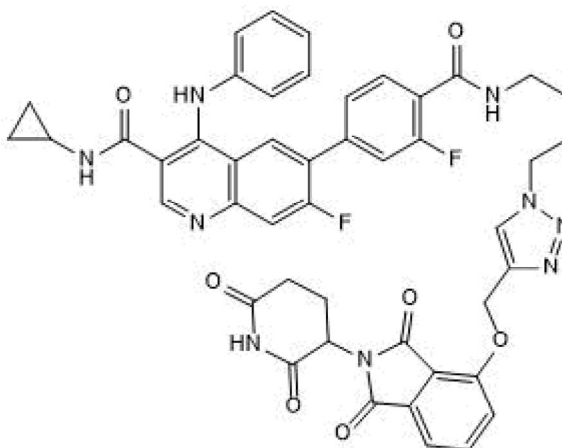

Description:

aTAG 4531 is a degrader of MTH1 fusion proteins for use within the aTAG system. Comprises a ligand selective for MTH1, a linker and the cereblon-binding ligand Thalidomide (Cat. No. 0652). Induces highly potent and selective degradation of fusion proteins after a 4 h incubation (DC₅₀ = 0.34 nM; D_{max} = 93.14%). Cell-permeable. Suitable for in vitro and in vivo applications. Mouse DMPK properties are provided in the supplementary file (see below). MTH1 can be expressed as a fusion with a target protein of interest using genome engineering techniques via CRISPR-mediated locus-specific knock-in. See protocol for more information. 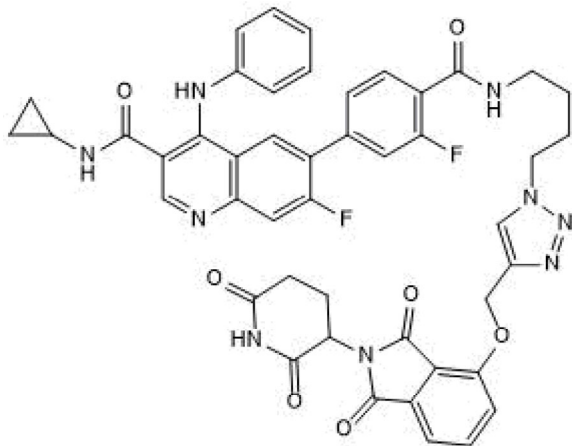

Stability and Solubility Advice:
