


Dinaciclib is a potent and selective inhibitor of CDK2, CDK5, CDK1 and CDK9 activity in vitro (IC_{50} values are 1, 1, 3 and 4 nM, respectively). Dinaciclib is a DNA replication inhibitor that blocks thymidine DNA incorporation in A2780 cells with an IC_{50} of 4 nM. Dinaciclib induced regression of established solid tumors in mouse models and shows strong antiviral activity across two cell lines (Vero E6, IC_{50} = 0.127 µM; A549-ACE2, IC50 = 0.032 µM).
