Description:

EM12-SO $_2$ F is a potent covalent Cereblon (CRBN) inhibitor (IC $_{50}$ = 0.88 nM) it covalently binds to a histidine residue (His353) in the IMiD binding pocket of CRBN and blocks the recruitment of its substrates. It prevents Lenalidomide (Cat. No. 6305) induced degradation of the zinc finger transcription factor IKZF1in MOLT4 cells. it complements CRBN based PROTAC and genetic methods to validate CRBN-mediated degradation.



Stability and Solubility Advice:
