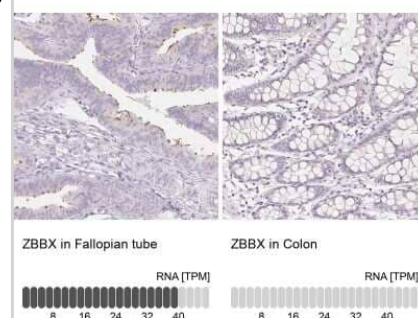

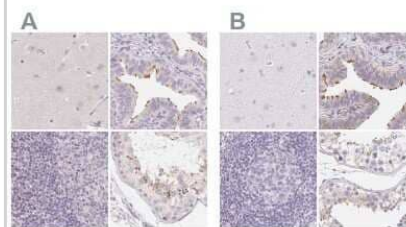

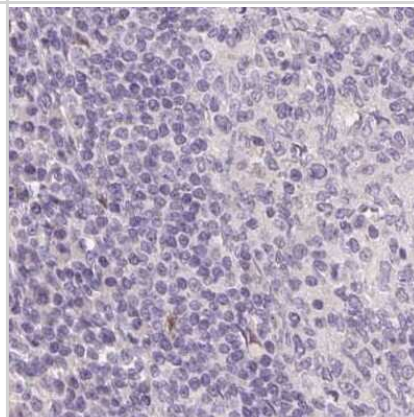

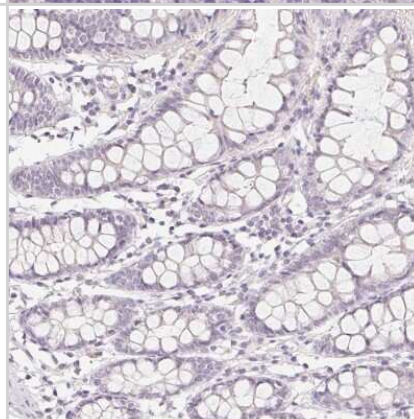

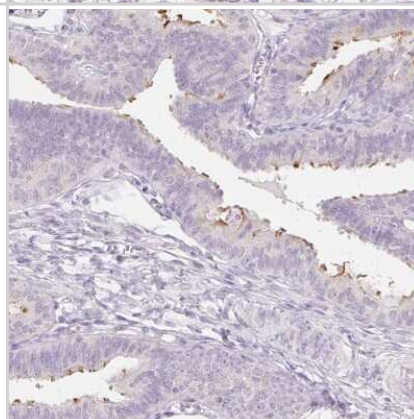
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: ZBBX Antibody [NBP1-82092] - Staining of human lymph node.



Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: ZBBX Antibody [NBP1-82092] - Staining of human colon shows low expression as expected.



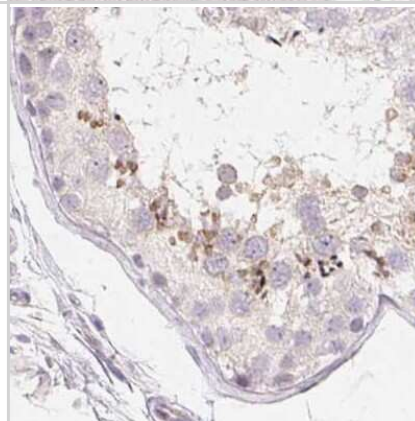
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: ZBBX Antibody [NBP1-82092] - Staining of human fallopian tube shows high expression.
